

Authorization to Recover a Domain currently in the Redemption Grace Period (RGP)

If your domain is in the Redemption Grace Period (RGP), then your domain name was not renewed prior to its expiry date and was deleted.

Deleted domains are held by the Registry for 30 days after deletion, and are recoverable during this period. Only the former Registrant can authorize to recover a domain name in RGP.

This form **MUST** be accompanied by a copy of the Whois information for the domain in RGP.

Please note: Recovery of a domain may take several days, and is a manual process. A Domain Recovery authorization that is received too late during the 30-day Redemption Grace Period (RGP) may not be recoverable.

Individuals

For a domain name registered to an individual, this form must be printed, filled in as required and faxed to the number provided below.

Individuals must also include a photocopy displaying both sides of their Driver's License.

Namescout.com reserves the right to request that this form be notarized as proof of the individual's identity.

Companies

For domains registered by companies or organizations, this form must be printed on official letterhead, filled in as required and signed by an officer of the corporation.
